## THE COUNCIL OF ASEAN CHIEF JUSTICES (CACJ) RETREAT 2023

The Malaysian Judiciary recently hosted the CACJ Retreat which was attended by all the ASEAN Chief Justice and Heads of Delegation. This retreat, agreed upon last year and set to be held every decade, offered a unique platform for strategic planning and unrestricted dialogue.

The CACJ Retreat began with a Commemoration Ceremony on 19<sup>th</sup> October 2023 to mark the CACJ's 10th Anniversary. This ceremony, held in the iconic Palace of Justice in Putrajaya, witnessed the launch of the Compilation of the Model Rule on Service of Civil Processes and the Model Rule on the Taking of Evidence for Foreign Proceedings in Civil or Commercial Matters. Additionally, the compilation of the Governance Framework on the Use of Artificial Intelligence in the ASEAN Judiciaries (Al Governance Framework) was also inaugurated. These pivotal instruments were the fruits of laborious work undertaken by both the CACJ Working Group on Facilitating Service of Civil Processes within ASEAN and CACJ Working Group on Case Management and Court Technology which is helmed by Malaysia. The momentous ceremony was further enhanced with the Plumeria tree planting ceremony by the Right Honourable Tun Tengku Maimun binti Tuan Mat, the Chief Justice of Malaysia and Chair of the CACJ, and the Honourable Sundaresh Menon, the Chief Justice of Singapore who is also one of the founding members of the CACJ. In reverence of a remarkable decade, the CACJ 10th Anniversary special commemorative stamp collection was also unveiled.

The second part of the CACJ Retreat took place on 20<sup>th</sup> October 2023 where the ASEAN Chief Justices congregated in a more intimate and informal setting. The second part of the Retreat presented the ASEAN Chief Justices with a valuable occasion to assess the CACJ's triumphs and tribulations in a comprehensive manner, and to ponder on how the CACJ can stay pertinent and reactive to imminent developments and tribulations. Five key areas were the centre of focus in the second part of the Retreat, namely, Capacity Building, the ASEAN Judiciaries Portal,

Judicial and Court Excellence, Cooperation Frameworks within ASEAN, and Outreach and External Relations.

The culmination of the CACJ Retreat was the Gala Dinner which was concurrently held in conjunction with the 14<sup>th</sup> ASEAN Law Association (ALA) General Assembly, ASEAN Law Conference and 44<sup>th</sup> ALA Governing Council Meeting.
